#### **The Position**

There is one (1) current full-time vacancy in the Energy Delivery Division of the Public Utilities Department.

Positions designated as Non-Classified are exempt from the classified service. The Incumbent shall be appointed "at-will" and serve at the pleasure of the City Manager.

Under general direction, to plan, assign, supervise and review professional electrical engineering work; to assist the division head in developing and carrying out policies and programs; and to do related work as required.

#### **Minimum Qualifications**

**Education:** Graduation with a Bachelor's Degree in electrical engineering from a college or university with an accredited four or five year degree program in electrical engineering. A Bachelor's Degree in civil or mechanical engineering from a college or university with an accredited four or five year degree program and two additional years' experience doing professional electrical utility engineering can substitute for an electrical engineering degree. Registration as a Professional Engineer cannot substitute for the required education.

**Experience:** Three years' experience in professional electric utility engineering work comparable to that of a Senior Electrical Engineer in the City of Riverside Electric Utility.

Possession of an appropriate, valid class "C" California Motor Vehicle Operator's License.
