The Southern California Public Power Authority (SCPPA) is seeking internship candidates who can use direct field experience to support their educational programs, potentially obtain educational credits, and work in a supporting role to the existing staff or one of the SCPPA members. Work locations may be at the SCPPA office in Pasadena, or at a SCPPA member utility location.

OVERVIEW OF SCPPA

SCPPA was created in 1980 by the publicly owned utilities (POUs) in Southern California to provide financing for their participation in electric generating facilities and high voltage transmission lines.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The position is designated as a temporary, part-time internship and the engagement with the intern will be an “at will,” temporary engagement.
- Internship working hours are not to exceed an aggregate maximum of 950 hours, and will be based on a combination of intern availability and potential assignments.
- Primary work location may be at the SCPPA office, located at 225 S. Lake Avenue, Suite 1250, Pasadena, California 91101; or at one of the SCPPA member utility sites.
- SCPPA may offer monetary compensation to candidates.
- Candidates are not eligible for employment or other benefits.
- Other requirements or restrictions may apply.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Provide a cover letter describing your interests, capabilities, and objectives in working for SCPPA (or a specific SCPPA Member Utility) in the role of an intern. Also, please include your available start and end dates, local address, working schedule(s) or preferences.
2. Provide your resume including educational program objectives.
3. Provide details of your institution’s internship program which define how educational units may be gained, or any requirements or restrictions on work being performed.
