The first screening of applications will be July 17, 2020. However, the City reserves the right to stop accepting applications prior to the posted deadline, if sufficient numbers of qualified applications are received. Therefore, applicants are encouraged to apply IMMEDIATELY. The recruitment is officially closed once it has been removed from the City's website.

The City of Lompoc is seeking candidates for **Utility Director**. The position is the executive manager responsible for planning, organizing, directing, and evaluating municipal utilities systems and programs, which include: water production, storage, and distribution systems; wastewater collection, treatment and reclamation operations; electrical distribution, electrical generation and transmission through a Joint Power Agency; refuse and recycling collection and disposal, City landfill; and a broadband network with Wi-Fi connections for internet access. The incumbent receives direction from and is responsible to the City Manager for day-to-day operations.

Typical Qualifications: Include Bachelor's Degree in Engineering, Natural Science, Environmental Science, or related field **AND** seven (7) years responsible experience in utilities systems administration, including at least three (3) years in a management capacity.

Ideal Candidate: Would possess direct working experience in at least one of the four major areas of responsibilities; water, wastewater, solid waste, and/or electrical distribution systems. Telecommunications and Wireless Internet Service Provider experience would also be beneficial.

Application Process: Candidates must complete a City employment application (include copies of any professional certificates), résumé, and three professional references. All completed application packets will be reviewed.

Examination Process: Based on the information provided, the best qualified applicants will be invited for further examination. The examination process may consist of, but not limited to, a formal panel interview, in-basket and/or written exercise. Subsequently, top candidates will be invited for follow-up interview with the City Administrator.

Selection Process: The candidate ultimately chosen for the position, as authorized by City and state policy, will be subject to a background investigation and live scan fingerprinting for purposes of investigating criminal history for certification and employment consideration. In addition, a City-paid medical exam (based upon job-related physical standards) by a City-designated physician is required
