EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR LADWP RELIABILITY PROJECT ONLY

Scoring Criteria	Score (100%)
Proposer's Qualifications and Experience — Provide a description of similar or related services performed by the proposer. Provide references for work similar in size and complexity to tasks described in the statement of work.	15%
Qualification of Key Personnel — Provide a summary of qualifications and experience of key personnel who will work on the contract.	15%
Approach to the Work — the proposal has shown an understanding of what was requested under this RFP. Provide information that is detailed enough to demonstrate that the Proposer has the project management skills to deliver the required project on time. (Scope and Schedule). The proposer has answered the project development questions posed in the RFP (Scope). The proposal submitted has all scope of the work assigned such as design, EPC and construction.	10%
Technical Approach — Provide sufficient information to demonstrate the Proposer's understanding of the technical requirements. The proposer has answered technical questions posed in the RFP, and Appendix A. Must comprehensively describe the approach for meeting all of the requirements of the Statement of Work or Scope of Services. Particular emphasis should be given to confirm depth and breadth of technical and/or industry knowledge.	25%
Meets Requested Requirements — Proposal meets minimum and requested requirements provided in the RFP and Appendix A.	15%
Solvent and Stable — The proposer has provided evidence that the proposer's business is solvent and that the vendor could be a sound possible long term partner.	10%
Cost Competitiveness/ Economics Evaluation — The purpose of the Fee Schedule is to provide a summary of incurred and estimated costs. Proposer's estimate of budgetary costs should be competitive with other bidders and be adequate within the context of the scope and scale of the project.	10%
