PRIMARY FUNCTION:

Under general direction, supervises, plans and coordinates work activities of the vegetation management program and energy compliance including the electrical technical training of power troubleshooting, line construction, substation, and metering personnel; interfaces, plans, coordinates and reviews work activities of contractors to ensure conformance to written specifications and compliance with OSHA and other applicable regulations; prepares and presents vegetation management and OSHA safety training programs including equipment and tool standard requirements in the areas of line construction, substations and metering units; and directs the development of instructional material, G.O. 95, 128, NEC, ANSI, OSHA, District SOP, SWP, safety training and other required documentation. Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree in arboriculture, occupational safety, industrial hygiene, business administration, or a related field and five years of progressively responsible experience as a utility line clearance, journey-level lineman or other related certified utility fieldwork experience; and experience leading and training a crew.

Progressively responsible directly related experience may be substituted for the required education at the ratio of two years of experience for one year of education required in utility line clearance experience, including five years working in a supervisory or lead capacity.

LICENSING & CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Certification by the International Society of Arboriculture as a Tree Worker or Arborist is required or ability to obtain within the initial probationary period.

OSHA General Industry and Construction Outreach Instructor Certification is desired.

Lineman qualified electrical worker is desired.

A valid driver license issued by the State of California, Department of Motor Vehicles is required.

An official current driving record (obtained within the last six months) from your local State Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) or from official DMV website must accompany job application (no third party records accepted).
